Fairfield Plantation in Camden County, Georgia

Fairfield Plantation was the home of Congressman John Floyd, born 3 October 1769 on Hilton Head Island, South Carolina, and died on his plantation in Camden County on 24 June 1839.

The plantation is located in Camden County at Fairfield Point, near Bellvue and Hermitage Plantations.

All of these plantations are on private property. It is located midway up the coast of Camden County.

North of Pine Barrens and Bellevue and East of Hermitage Plantations. Floyd's Neck.

The Floyd Family Cemetery is located about a quarter of a mile from the site of the former Fairfield Plantation House.
